- 15+ years of age
- Criminal Record Check (fee, if any, will be reimbursed with receipt)

Commitment

1-2 shifts per month, usually 2-3 hours per shift. Shifts are scheduled in advance. Most facilitator shifts occur on Saturdays. Some shifts may occur during the evenings.
